The Anglican Parish of Gander will be holding our Annual Summer Camp at Mint Brook from Thursday August 21 – Saturday August 23rd.

The purpose of our camp is to provide an outdoor camping experience for youth in a Christian setting. During the 2 ½ days at camp, young people will have the opportunity to take part in activities such as : sports ,canoeing, hiking, swimming crafts etc – all in a supervised setting.

Campers will enjoy nutritious cooked meals, fresh fruit, canteen breaks and the benefit of our full washroom and shower facilities.

Campers sleep in groups of 8 – 10 in our cabins, and become part of sports and recreation teams to ensure “a good time is had by all!”

This is our third Parish Camp - Providing a wonderful and positive experience for our youth.

Guidelines and Rules

If you attend Camp you must be prepared to follow the Camp rules and guidelines:

- Cigarettes, matches, lighters, alcohol, drugs, are strictly prohibited on Camp grounds.
- Absolutely, No swearing.
- Campers are not to go to the river or wander into the woods area without being accompanied by a staff member.
- Campers must participate in camp scheduled activities and stay with their group as assigned.
- Campers are not permitted to sleep in any Cabin other than their assigned Cabin.
- No bullying and /or fighting.
- Cabins must be cleaned at the request of camp staff.
- Campers must be willing to participate in camp chores; dishes, cleanup, etc.
- Plus other rules assigned at Camp by the Director.

What to Bring

Things to Consider when packing your bag for camp (In addition to regular clothes.)

- Rain wear / Short Rubber Boots
- Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- Sun Screen AND Fly repellent
- Flash light
- A second pair of footwear
- Bathing suit / swim wear
- Extra towels for swimming
- Money for 4 to 5 Canteens (Limit of 2 items per Canteen)
- Ball glove / bat / softball (Optional)
- Board Game (Optional)
- Musical Instrument (Optional but welcomed !)

PLEASE DO NOT OVER PACK AS THERE IS LIMITED ROOM ON THE SCHOOL BUS !!!

- **If campers break the above rules - parents will be contacted, and campers may be sent home.**

CAMP FEES The Cost for camp is **\$35.00 per camper** If you have more than one Child the Cost for each additional child is \$25.00. This fee includes transportation to and from camp, meals; craft supplies extra treats for the kids, and the Diocesan fee.

The Parish of Gander raises and budgets money for this camp every year in order to keep your costs down. Our cost to use Mint Brook has risen this year. **If finances are a concern – don't let that stop your child from coming. Please call Revd. John!**
